



Vowel pronunciation guidelines (minute 3:08)

When two vowels go walking, the first one does the talking.



Pronunciation: Vowels

Two Vowel Guideline (- NOT A RULE)
 = 1st vowel sounds like its alphabet name (long vowel sound)
 = 2nd vowel is silent ☹️

bake these pie drone
 fame dream ice soap

One Vowel Guideline (NOT A RULE)
 = the vowel sounds like its relative

 jam bend pin
