## **SPANISH EXPERIENCE**

"The Spanish Experience" offers Spanish classes for beginner, intermediate, and advanced learners. These lessons are combined with outdoor activities in Guayaquil. So, students will be able to put their language knowledge into practice and get to know more about Ecuadorian people and way of life.

## **EXPERIENCIES**

**Going downtown**: Walk along 9 de Octubre street until Malecon identifying different shops and asking for prices.

- Visit "Parque Seminario" near de Cathedral and identify people and places nearby.
- Visit 3 different stores and ask for prices (electronics or clothes stores). Talk about differences in prices and customer service in shops in your own country and Guayaquil.
- Visit a supermarket. What do Ecuadorian people eat? Identify names of food and items at the supermarket.
- Getting coffee or ice cream. Students can try some typical desserts like "torta de choclo" (corn cake) or humitas (corn grains with cheese). Time for sharing impressions about the experience, review vocabulary and expressions.

## Visit Museo del Cacao

- Walk along the Panama Street.
- Students will learn vocabulary and expressions related to cacao and its importance for the Ecuadorian economy.
- Different styles of living (countryside, city).
- Getting chocolate or typical dishes at one of the restaurants and coffee shops around the Panama Street. Students can try some typical dishes like "bolon de verde" (plantain ball with cheese or pork).
- Time for sharing impressions about the experience, review vocabulary and expressions.
